- 2. Husbandry
 - Nutritional requirements
 - Temperature
 - Humidity
 - Lighting requirements
 - Housing
 - Social structure

- 1. History
 - Species specific
 - VERY detailed
- 2. Distant examination
 - BEFORE you touch the animal
- 3. Hands on physical examination
- 4. Diagnostics
- Photos



EXOTIC ANIMAL EVALUATION ~Species Specific Normals~



Complete Patient Picture

- Look for underlying issues consistent with neglect
 - a. Husbandry deficits
 - Recurrent?
 - b. Physical examination findings
 - Correlate with husbandry?
 - c. Diagnostics
 - Supportive of neglect?















EXOTIC ANIMAL ABUSE EVALUATION

- Diagnostics
 - Radiographs- 2 view
 - Evaluate bone density
 - Previous or acute fractures
 - Bloodwork
 - CBC, Ca:P, iCa



EXOTIC ANIMAL ABUSE EVALUATION

- Monitoring- provides additional information
 - Decompensation- prey species
 - Clinical improvement with improved husbandry
 - Can be acute and significant
 - May be supportive of previous husbandry deficits
 - Hydration
 - Defecation
 - Body temperature



EXOTIC ANIMAL ABUSE & NEGLECT ~Take Homes~

- Recognize degree of species differences
- Utilize resources for proper assessment
- Detailed history, distant exam, physical exam
 - Document everything (incl. photos)
- Continue to monitor
 - Daily care and response to treatment/improved husbandry
